Dear SDG-F Steering Committee,

I am writing to you in response to the official letter sent by the SDG-F Steering Committee on 22 December 2017, notifying the SDG-F partners of the decision to wind-down the SDG Fund in 2018 to ensure coherence and alignment of inter-agency pooled funding mechanisms supporting SDGs. As per this decision, it is our understanding that the SDG-F Steering Committee has decided to allocate up to 1 million US dollars for the Food Africa project in Nigeria for activities & mid-term evaluation ending in 2018.

In response to this decision, the following action has been taken by the SDG-F partners in Nigeria to revise the proposal for the Food Africa programme:

- Inclusion of an evaluation by year-end 2018;
- Reduction of the budget allocation from SDG Fund's side to US \$1,000,000;
- Reconsideration and revision of the programmatic interventions to ensure that the programme will be operationally closed by year-end 2018.

Please find attached the revised proposal for the SDG Fund Secretariat's kind submission to the SDG Fund Steering Committee by 19 January 2018.
